As you know, our primary, church-wide emphasis for 2023 is now underway and continues through October—what we've entitled **Northlake Connects**. This community-engagement effort stands on four pillars, one focus for each week. Week 1 is devoted to **Reaching Your One**—leaning into relationships beyond the church by showing love and sharing faith. One of the first places God has led your Vision Team is to this irreplaceable need. Will you join us in (re)discovering prayer—both individually and corporately? Please make time to join us for PrayerFIRST on Wednesday, June 7 (we'll pause in July and August, then resume in September). We're also considering some prayer guides, prayer vigils and other activities that can bring us to our knees...to hear His voice and awaken His blessing. Remember, Jesus said that we should "seek first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness" (Matthew 6:33).
