This month, we will be receiving funds for missions in the state of Texas. Our church goal is \$3,800, and the week of prayer is Sept 10-17.


Land Sale Vote

instead of waiting for them to COME. Most importantly, use those conversations as a bridge—looking for the one with whom God is leading you to build intentional relationship. Don't just deliver INVITATIONS; make CONNECTIONS, letting God use YOU to reach THEM. Much has changed in modern culture; the lost rarely look for churches ...churches must look for the lost. So, step beyond comfort zones into community. Let God open doors, touch hearts and foster connection through your intentional efforts! Begin praying even now for that one person or family with whom you can connect. Remember, the tool is PICKLE-BALL, but our goal is RELATION-SHIP. May God bless our efforts to touch this community and Tell His Story.

This fall, we launch our next Deacon Nomination Cycle—giving you a chance to recommend those you would like us to consider for service as a <u>new</u> deacon at Northlake. All nominees must be vetted in light of the biblical requirements of 1 Timothy 3; those qualified (and willing) would then be interviewed by the Deacon Body, presented to the church, and affirmed with a service of commitment (ordination) later this year. Join with me in praying for God to raise up men who, with their wives, would be worthy additions to this servantcentered body. Nomination forms will be available beginning on September 10; all nominations must be received by Sept 24.

Finally, we've been studying the question of selling land the church owns north of our building (the soccer field), acquired for future facility expansion. Our FINANCE and PROPERTY & SPACE Committees met to discuss this possibility, opting to bring it before the church. We put together some Pros vs. Cons (in full disclosure), and an overview was shared on Sunday, August 27 by our Church Treasurer. Now, you have another chance for discussion/questions on Wednesday, September 13 at 7:00 pm, followed by a simple yes-or-no vote (by ballot) during the service on Sunday, September 17—which would require at least 75% approval to move forward. Now, this is a BIG question, worthy of very careful consideration, so please join with me in praying for wisdom and clarity. There are differences of opinion on this issue, to be sure; but, no matter which direction the vote may lead us, let's strive for UNITY...even in the absence of UNIFORMITY. May God make His will known TO us and keep us focused on His plan FOR us!
