As we move further into 2024 (my 17th year as Northlake's pastor), we continue our focus on Northlake Connects—a 4-part emphasis on fostering relationships. Beginning in March, we'll devote week 1 to **Reach Your One**—looking for ways to share our faith, show His love and fulfill our mission by connecting with those beyond our current circle of friends/family. Week 2 sees the return of our **HomeGrown Groups**, meeting in member's homes (one meets at church) for a time of fellowship, food (optional) and watching season 2 of "*The Chosen*." *Watch for sign-ups*

Activity of some kind, which varies from month-to-month. And week 4 is an often overlooked focus on Practicing Sabbath. As we saw last year, some months will shift that schedule due to holidays or other conflicts, but this is the basic plan for our calendar from March to October. So, make the time to take part in NORTHLAKE CONNECTS!

On the subject of Reaching Your One, let me address a new effort we've made to reach our community. We've always invested locally with multiple ministries (ESL, Food Pantry, Clothes Closet, Weaver Volunteers, etc.), but last year we began connecting more intentionally. We sent out teams with street assignments, going door-to-door to meet our neighbors...people from whom we've largely become disconnected. Usually, we've given a flyer inviting them to some free activity at Northlake to foster community...but our primary goal is making connections, planting seeds for future relationships. Now, many won't be interested, they may not speak English or they just refuse to answer the door. But it's not about reaching EVERYONE; it's about connecting with SOMEONE—finding your "person of peace," open to conversation. I implore you, as your pastor, leader and example: Join this COMMUNITY CONNECTION EFFORT! Many streets, many doors and many souls await, so we need willing walkers to get it done. If you've not (yet) found someone with whom build relationship—your "One"—perhaps God will lead you to them through this neighborhood initiative. Talk with me and take a street!

One final note. A generous donor has given \$10,000 to begin a fund to replace our aging marquee sign with a new, electronic one, giving us much greater flexibility with graphics and rotating messages. The cost for such a sign is around \$30,000, so we need additional sacrificial givers to step up to the plate—investing BEYOND THEIR REGULAR TITHE towards this project. As with our Roof Replacement Effort (Project Nehemiah), we won't move forward until money is given...so is this something You have a passion to complete? If so, talk with me or simply make a donation (by check or online), designating it for "Digital Sign." In our visual culture, graphics speak loudly, so help us make this a reality in 2024!
