Will you commit to sharing your faith more intentionally by focusing on your ONE? Will you embrace more consistent giving to help us meet—and exceed—our new budget, investing in ministry to expand His Kingdom? Is there a specific area of person-

al ministry where you can help us fulfill our mission? May we never forget that the church isn't about buildings, budgets, programs or staff positions...but PEOPLE. It's only as we <u>each</u> make the great INVESTMENT in the great COMMISSION through the great COMMANDMENT that we can become church God desires. So, are you fully committed to stand together with other members to Tell His Story, Build His Body and Seek His Glory?

This month, we continue our commitment to NORTHLAKE CONNECTS—being more intentional in personal evangelism (Reach Your One), strengthening relationships (HomeGrown), engaging church fellowship and pursuing purposeful rest (Practicing Sabbath). Perhaps the least understood part of that four-part emphasis is "Reaching Your One," which we set aside the first week of each month to engage. The undeniable reality of our post-Christian society is a growing disengagement from organized faith; *about 30% of A mericans now identify as NONE (no particular religious affiliation)*. Very few unbelievers simply show up on their own; we must take the initiative to connect, start conversations, pursue relationships and share Jesus. The only way we will grow is for individual members to step UP and reach OUT—looking for those outside your Christian circle with whom to cultivate friendship. It may be a neighbor, co-worker, fellow student or someone on your assigned street in Northlake's ongoing Community Connection effort. The point is it begins with YOU: Pray for God open your eyes to that person in whom you should invest—a not-yet-believer that needs to know Christ…who may be drawn to faith by your love. The answer to empty seats is engaged saints who take the Great Commission seriously and personally. *Are you being obedient to SEEK and REACH your "one"*?

Please join me in praying for our STUDENT MINISTER SEARCH TEAM as they seek God's will for the future of our Student Ministry. We've posted the position and begun calling for resumes; our next step is to evaluate individual candidates to find the next person for this critical role. The process can't be <u>rushed</u>, but it must be <u>prioritized</u> as we strive to strengthen and expand this ministry area at Northlake. *Lift up the team who stands in the gap to hear God's voice*!
