Spring has (almost) sprung...although March has a tendency to throw one last freeze our way. Yet, we know warmer—and longer—days are coming, bringing hope of new growth and rebirth. As we move into March, we're also seeing "growth" in the next phase of our **Student Ministry**. In late February, the Personnel Committee made the unanimous decision to hire **Katie Cave** as our *Interim Minister of Students*—bringing a <u>wealth</u> of experience, training and biblical wisdom to the role (she just finished her Masters from Dallas Theological Seminary). Also, we voted to appoint a STUDENT MINISTER SEARCH

TEAM to begin the task of seeking the person God will bring to that permanent role. There's no way for us to know how long it may take, but please join me in praying for this team (and Katie) as they invest in this critical area of our ministry. *May He do greater things for our good and His glory!*

This month also launches the 2024 edition of NORTHLAKE CONNECTS—striving to be more intentional in personal evangelism (Reach Your One), group relationships (HomeGrown), church fellowships and purposeful rest (Practicing Sabbath). On the subject of Reaching Your One, let me address the outreach we're doing to meet our neighbors. We've always had multiple local ministries (ESL, Food Pantry, Clothes Closet, Weaver Volunteers, etc.), but last year we began connecting more proactively. We sent out teams with street assignments, going door-to-door to meet those around us...people from whom we've largely become disconnected. Usually, we've given a flyer inviting them to an activity at Northlake...but our primary qoal is making connections, planting seeds for future relationships. Now, many aren't interested, they may not speak English or they don't even answer the door. But it has never been about reaching EVERYONE; it's about connecting with SOMEONE—finding a "person of peace," willing to listen. And, it's a LONG-TERM EFFORT—measured in months and years, not weeks. I implore you, as your pastor, leader and example: Join this COMMUNITY CONNECTION EFFORT! Many streets, many doors and many souls await, so we need willing walkers to get it done. Our next outreach event is Wednesday, March 27 at 6:30 pm. So, talk with me and take a street!

Finally, just a reminder that March is the month when we present our **Proposed Budget** for the next fiscal year (April 1, 2024 – March 31, 2025). On Sunday morning, March 10, we approach this in a <u>different</u> way than I've done it before—giving a "big-picture" view of what we feel God is calling us to accomplish, complete with personal testimonies from faithful givers. We'll also send out PLANNED-GIVING CARDS to enlist your commitment toward our goal. You'll be able to ask questions between March 10 and March 24 when we vote to adopt this new budget.
