HOW TO STRENGTHEN YOUR FAITH

Luke 8:40-56

These two miracles in Luke 8 are linked together as a story within a story. While Jesus is on his way with Jairus who has a 12-year-old daughter who is dying, He is interrupted to heal a woman who has been sick for 12 years. Both miracle stories are also linked on the theme of strengthening our faith in Jesus.

1. STRONG FAITH MUST BE _____.

- “No one could heal her.” (v. 43)
- “She came up behind him and touched the edge of his cloak” (v. 44)
- “Who touched me?” Jesus asked. (v. 45)
- “Daughter, your faith has healed you. Go in peace.” (v. 48)

2. STRONG FAITH MUST BE _____.

- “His only daughter, a girl about twelve, was dying.” (v. 42)
- “While Jesus was still speaking, someone came . . . Your daughter is dead.” (v. 49)
- Jesus said to Jairus, “Don’t be afraid, just believe, and she will be healed.” (v. 50)

When the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on the earth? (Lk 18:8)
But I have prayed for you, Simon, that your faith may not fail. (Lk 22:32)
