#### HE WILL SWALLOW UP DEATH FOREVER

Isaiah 25:6-9, 1 Corinthians 15:53-57

Today, we celebrate that after Jesus was crucified on Friday, He was resurrected on Sunday morning! Not only did Jesus make possible the forgiveness of sins to those who believe in Him, but He also destroyed death. What does this mean for the believer that Jesus has destroyed death?

### 1. ISAIAH'S PROPHECY (Isaiah 25:6-9)

"He will swallow up death forever, The Sovereign Lord will wipe away the tears from all faces." (v. 8)

#### 2. NEW TESTAMENT

"Our Savior, Christ Jesus, who has destroyed death" (2 Tim. 1:10)

"by his death he might destroy him who holds the power of death—that is, the devil and free those who all their lives were held in slavery by their fear of death. (Heb. 2:14-15)

"He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away." (Revelation 21:4)
